


- **Testimonial History:** Experts tend to omit cases with unfavorable outcomes from their CV. This report lists all prior cases in which the expert testified so that you can get a truer sense of their track record.
- **Enhanced Challenge:** Review the expert's excluded testimony in prior cases to identify potential weaknesses.

- **Professional Discipline:** Find out if the expert was disciplined within their field.
- **Articles Naming an Expert:** See if the expert has received glowing press or if a negative event occurred in their life such as an arrest or conviction.
- **Articles Written by an Expert:** Read abstracts summarizing what the expert has published to better assess their depth of knowledge and communication skills. You can order full articles if needed.

Other Notable Features

Expert Witness On-Demand offers a variety of search tools. Find experts by name, qualifications, similar cases, and other attributes. Alternatively, search scientific and medical literature to identify potential experts who have not previously served as one.
